The members of the PWC see that tonight, the City Council will be asked to authorize city staff to submit a grant application to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's Regional Measure 3 (RM3) Safe Routes to Transit and Bay Trail Program (SR2TBT) for the Petaluma River Trail. This trail is lower priority. A rehabilitated Trestle meets all of the City Council's five main goals as well as being a high priority project.
