About the Program

- Launched October 2023
- Enables community members to nominate streets for traffic calming or safety improvements
- Accessible, transparent, data-driven
- Prioritizes streets with highest collision history
- Provides pathway for near-term fixes, especially on residential and collector streets



Safe Streets Nomination Program Overview

1. Nomination Received

Accepted on rolling basis at cityofpetaluma.org/ssnp

2. Preliminary Engineering Review & Screening

Reviewed for eligibility and to gain general idea of concern/possible solutions

3. Data Collection & Scoring

Nominations mapped, scored, and ranked

4. Project Design & Neighborhood Engagement


Designs developed for high-scoring projects; significant changes may require more engagement

5. Project Installation

Projects will be installed in score order as resources allow; remaining nominations will be rolled over for consideration in following year

First Round Scoring

- 537 nominations received by mid-February (236 unique locations mapped within City limits)
- Updated scoring criteria to account for high volume of submissions:
 - Injury collisions only; more points for higher severity
 - Not using speed data
 - Proximity to schools and parks adjusted
