I will thoroughly research the issues at hand to get a deeper understanding of the problem, and contribute to the decisions that will be for the best interest of the environment.

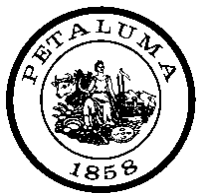
How do you feel about the climate crisis? How will this perspective strengthen the Climate Action Commission?

I would work towards the installation of sidewalks and other pedestrian improvements along all major thoroughfares. Specifically, Lakeville Street, Petaluma Boulevard North, and Corona Road. With the development of the SMART station at Corona Road a plan must be developed to allow pedestrians to cross safely over 101 and walk to various destinations along Petaluma Boulevard North which are currently inaccessible. I would also work towards Petaluma's integration into a larger system of bicycle and pedestrian pathways in Sonoma County, linking the city to the North, South, East, and West. In particular I would advocate for the development of a pedestrian pathway linking Petaluma and the City of Sonoma as part of the California Missions Trail. Finally I would use my experience growing up in Mill Valley and walking the Steps, Lanes, and Paths to begin to develop some aspects of such a walking system for Petaluma. In particular intuitive signage that a teenager or senior citizen would be able to understand to move along a pathway across the city.

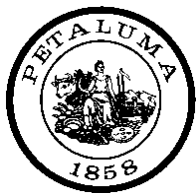
How do you feel about the climate crisis? How will this perspective strengthen the Climate Action Commission?
