RESOLUTION ACCEPTING CLAIMS AND BILLS FOR OCTOBER, NOVEMBER AND
DECEMBER 2024

WHEREAS, the proposed action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15378, in that paying the City’s claims and bills does not meet CEQA's definition of a “project,” because the action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and because the action constitutes organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment; and

WHEREAS, Section 64 of the Petaluma City Charter requires that the City Auditor shall examine all claims and bills and the City Manager shall approve them for payment; and
