#### What is the heart of Petaluma?

#### ACTIVE RECREATION:

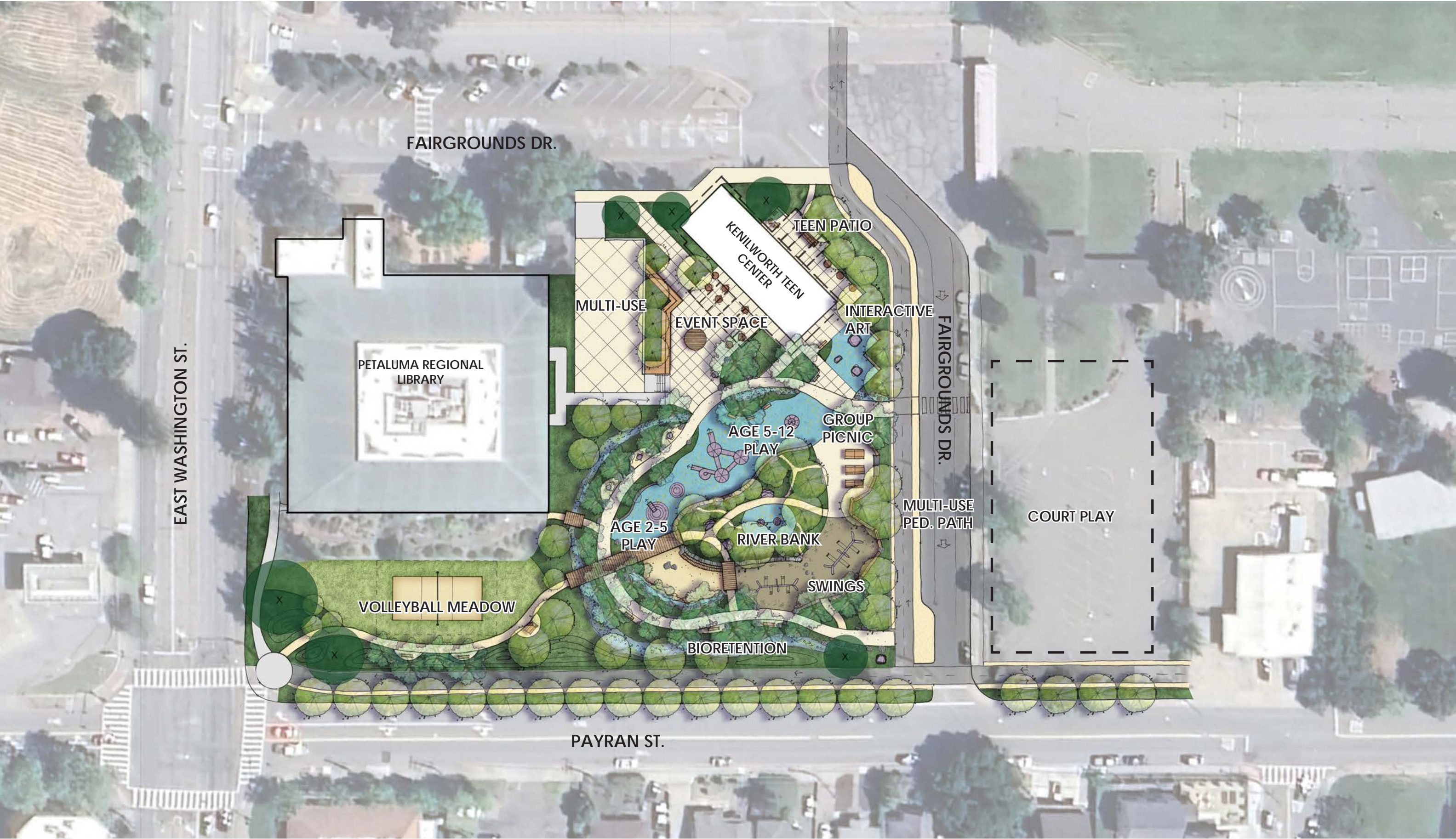
Drop-in volleyball and court play.

#### CONNECT TO NATURE:

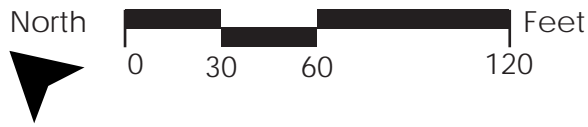

# KENILWORTH PARK AND PLAYGROUND PUBLIC ART

- Petaluma Public Art Committee (PPAC) identified Kenilworth Park as an opportunity to create a unique, inclusive, and immersive public art experience
- PPAC’s goals include:
  - Creating a welcoming and memorable experience for children, teens, and families
  - Create visually stimulating environment that is unique, inspires creativity, a sense of wonder, play
  - Encourages cultural tourism by providing centrally located, accessible, family-friendly experience
  - Provide a “play-safe”, durable, immersive art space
- PPAC to select an artist/designer to focus on public art experience in Revitalization project
- PPAC commitment to support funding as key project stakeholder to integrate artwork(s) into park design





## ARTIST SELECTION - OLEG LOBYKIN

- Winter 2023 - PPAC identifies project inspiration for project opportunity
- May 1 to June 9 - Request for Qualifications for artist/designer
  - 24 eligible applications received
- June 2023 PPAC selects Oleg Lobykin
- Artist's design contract to work with MIG and City team to create seamless design of the park site plan with integrated public artworks
- Oleg Lobykin is a local Bay Area artist specializing in sculpture and stone carving, experience with playgrounds
- Lobykin inspired by the 'mystery of transformation and the natural world, creating portals to other dimensions with his art





***TITLE: SPLASH***

The theme recognizes the basic truth that “water is life,” essential to agriculture and food production and our very bodies. The design concept aims to educate and inspire children to recognize the vital nature of water through exploration, discovery, and stimulation of imagination through art.

The proposed playground sculptures form a group of pieces ranging in size from 4-12 feet high and 3-8 feet wide, made of GFRC (glass fiber reinforced concrete). They are suitable for climbing, safe and durable, perhaps with companion pieces for sitting. Featuring free-standing abstract sculptures in whimsical organic and biomorphic shapes, they represent void and substance while drawing attention to flow.

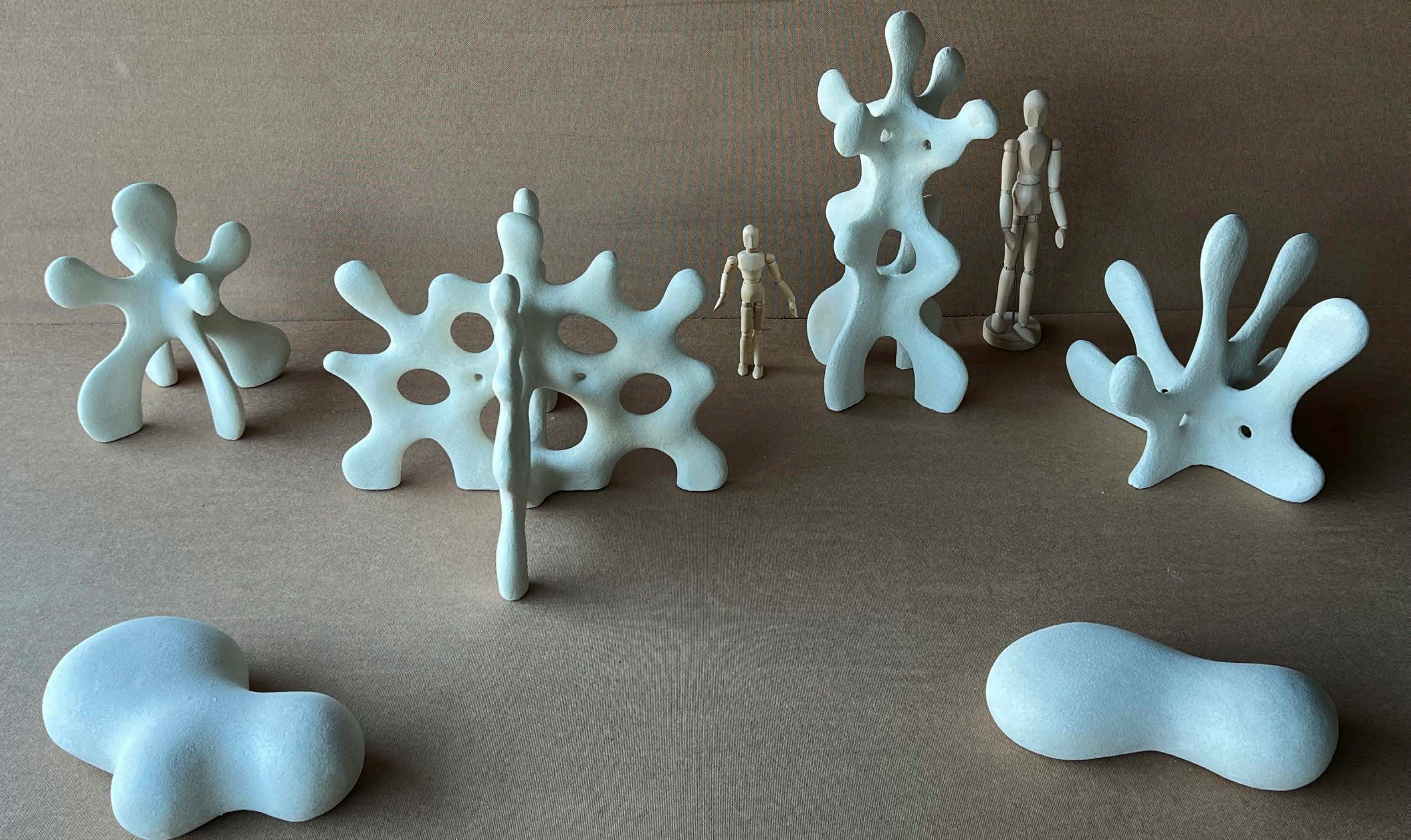

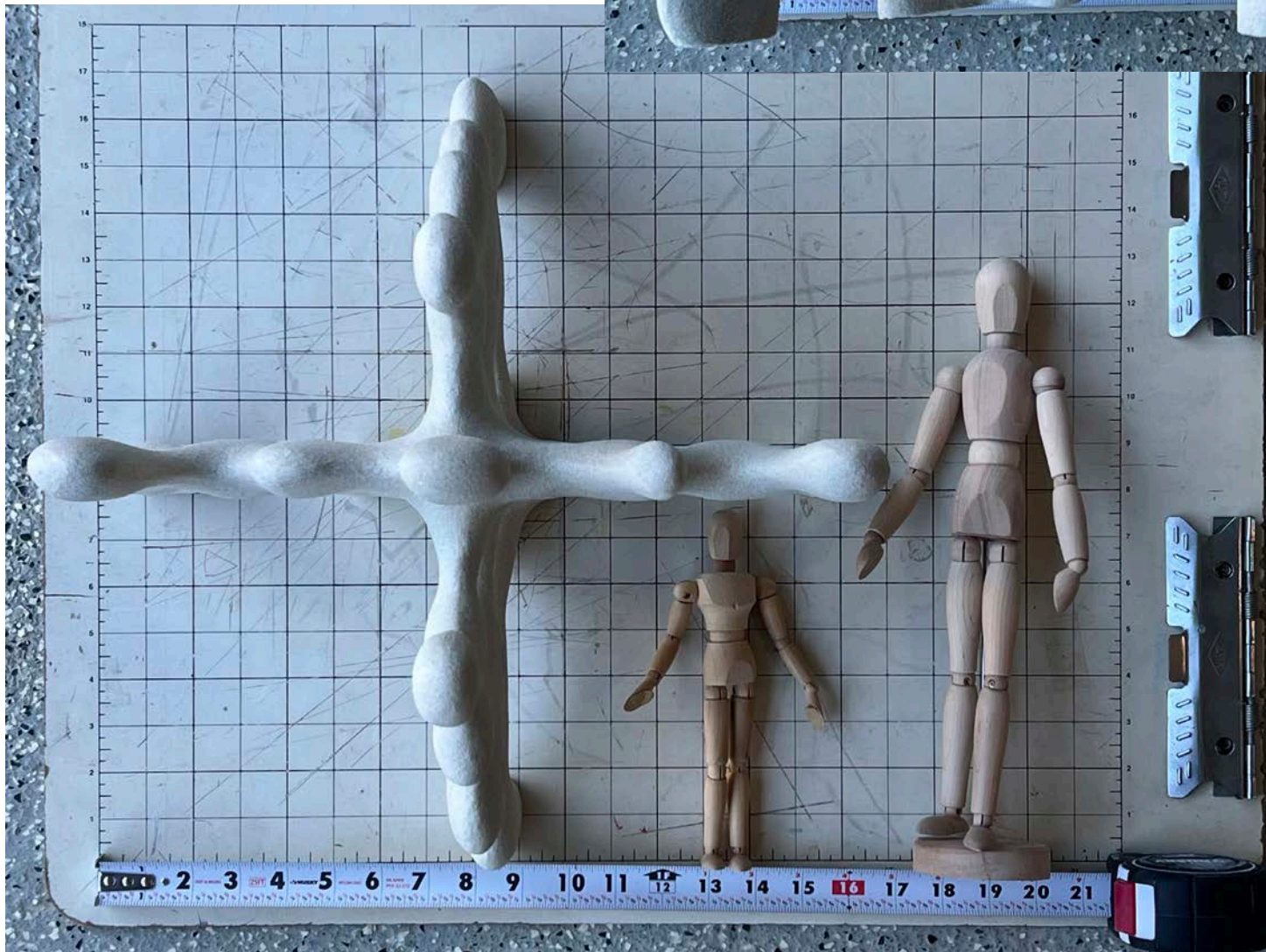
