RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PETALUMA APPROVING CITY COUNCIL LIASON TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2024, Council adopted Resolution No. 2024-048 N.C.S. which established the Public Safety Advisory Committee (PSAC); and

WHEREAS, the resolution indicates that, “The PSAC shall consist of six community members, representing diverse interests and backgrounds, and one City Council member as a City Council liaison to the committee, for a total of seven seats on the PSAC.”

WHEREAS, City Council Liaison appointments happen annually in January; City Council should appoint a City Council Liaison to the PSAC to serve until the next annual Council Liaison Appointments take place at the first Regular City Council Meeting in January; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor notified Councilmembers of the available position and solicited interest in being appointed to the position; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered the Mayor’s recommendation at the regular meeting on June 17, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Petaluma as follows:

1. Appoints Councilmember Dennis Pocekay as City Council Liaison to the Public Safety Advisory Committee, to serve until the first regular meeting in January 2025.

Under the power and authority conferred upon this Council by the Charter of said City.
