It has come to my attention that the school's relationship with the 4th DAA is untenable, and we cannot continue in our current space if the City of Petaluma does not take over our portion of the fairgrounds. A quick walk through our facilities makes it abundantly clear that the 4th DAA has not allowed us to maintain/replace what was meant to be temporary buildings in an acceptable manner.

My family loves Live Oak School- two of the main reasons we chose it was its central location, and great sense of community. As a parent of a Kindergartener, we have many years of school to go, and the current buildings need more work than the 4th DAA is willing to deal with.
