Dear CC members - I think it very important and telling that [KCPP](#) asked for an endorsement from the Sierra Club, and **the Sierra Club REFUSED to endorse Kelly Creek's project**. This is information you well need to be aware of. Although the Sierra Club's mission statement includes, "To explore, protect, and enjoy the wild places of the earth", they do not consider a human-centric park on this species-rich site to be a good idea. The remainder of their mission statement reads as follows:

- To practice and promote the responsible use of the earth's ecosystems and resources;
- To educate and enlist humanity to protect and restore the quality of the natural and human environment; and to use all lawful means to carry out these objectives.

I appreciate that they take their stewardship seriously (*i.e.*, "to use all lawful means necessary to carry out these objectives"). Please, in light of the fact that riparian corridors are biodiversity hubs, and that over 90 vertebrate wildlife species, including 17 special-status species, have been documented on this site, do not approve the Davidon subdivision and public park on top of this fragile watershed.
