Re: Petaluma Anti-housing Law: In opposition to making ("Residential Tenancy Ordinance") permanent

Dear Honorable Mayor McDonnell and Council Members,

This anti-housing law makes it nearly impossible to maintain rental properties, protect residents, and make necessary improvement to older rental homes.
