I would like to share my comment for this evening's Council meeting in regards to item #4: the current proposal to keep GPAC exclusively on the Zoom Platform.

Resolution Rescinding Resolutions No. 2021-014 and No. 2023-017 N.C.S. Appointing Members to the General Plan Advisory Committee to Allow Members to Volunteer to Continue Serving and Permit Continued Virtual GPAC Meetings Following Rescission of the COVID-19 State of Emergency which Will End the More Permissive AB 361 Teleconference Rules and Finding that this Action is not a "Project" Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5)

I would love to see the City adopt a hybrid method which would allow community volunteers to serve in a more accessible and equitable manner. This hybrid method would be hosting in person meetings for folks who are able to join in person and simultaneously have a large screen capability for folks unable to meet in person to attend remotely, via Zoom. I will volunteer myself as a member of GPAC who would be willing to help navigate this hybrid implementation.
