Additional info: We review each paving project against our Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan (map attached) for opportunities to implement proposed bikeways. Garfield Drive was not adopted/proposed as a bike route in the last plan—however, we are currently in the process of updating our plan, with a new draft map and project list available for public review and feedback in the coming weeks. We can watch the feedback very closely and can certainly consider adopting it as a Class III route and adding sharrows/signage after the paving project is complete. Unfortunately, in its current configuration with parking on both sides, we fall short of the width needed to accommodate bike lanes. If parking were removed on one side, we would be able to accommodate 6' bike lanes in both directions. That could also be considered, but would require more extensive community engagement.


