SUBJECT: Recommendation to Appoint a Citizen Representative to Sonoma County Transportation Authority Countywide Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee – Not a “Project” Pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act Section 15378

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Pedestrian and Bicycle Advisory Committee appoint a Citizen Representative to Sonoma County Transportation Authority (SCTA) Countywide Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee (CBPAC).

BACKGROUND & DISCUSSION

The SCTA CBPAC provides technical information related to bicycle and pedestrian planning, policy, and funding to the SCTA and meets the requirements of the Transportation Development Act (TDA), including any compliance with Article 3 of TDA.

The SCTA has designated up to twenty (20) members to serve on the CBPAC based on the 10 jurisdictions within Sonoma County. Each jurisdiction provides a staff person and, when available, a designated citizen representative. Regional agencies are considered ex-officio, non-voting members.

DISCUSSION

For jurisdictions with a local bicycle and pedestrian advisory committee, the citizen representative is chosen from the committee. The process for appointing representatives to the CBPAC is at the discretion of the jurisdiction making the appointment. Staff encourages the committee to consider implementing an annual appointment process, especially if multiple committee members are interested in participating.
