Dear City Planners,

This high level rendering (Bird's eye View Looking South) of the proposed Hotel Weaver in Petaluma is disingenuous and misleading

There are currently paint markings for street parking on B Street which are not shown here In this image a vehicle is parked in front of the entrance to the hotel parking garage entrance, thus blocking it (the parked vehicle in the image is hiding the driveway and the curb cut) Existing traffic signal poles are also not shown in the image

This image is fantasy It clearly was created with an intent to obscure the ugliness of 4 utility doors at street level along B Street (a large electric transformer room door, an electric switchgear equipment room door, a trash room/corridor door and a large garage door)

City planners should demand truthful renderings from applicants

I am opposed to the hotel as currently designed due to the unattractiveness of the B Street street level details
