In regards to the proposed water/wastewater rate increases, you need to advise the owner of Leisure Lake Village mobile home park to stop over-charging us residents on our wastewater. We all have separate meters & are charged for our actual usage for the regular water. But when it comes to the wastewater, they just divide the park's total by 135 spaces (of which the 135th is the park itself & all common areas: office, car wash, laundry, pool, plants, etc.). This means those of us with only 1 person in the household & those who conserve water are subsidizing the rest. Which means I'm paying, on average, \$14 a month more than I should be.

Please school them on how to bill us. As you say, "charges are billed based on metered water consumption". So our individual bills should be based on our actual usage, per our meter, not the parks.
