Considering Petaluma's limited Police resources, we also want to ask what can be done to reinforce the already existing policies stated under 21.040 of Petaluma's municipal code (link pasted below) in regard to very noisy altered vehicles, specifically the trucks we expect to arrive when the students return to Petaluma High School on August 16. the existence of these vehicles also seems counter-productive to Petaluma's goal of becoming carbon neutral by 2030.
